Dear Secretary Detzner,

Pursuant to Article I, Section 24 of the Florida Constitution, and chapter 119, F.S., I am requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain copies of public records that provide evidence of any and all cases of voter fraud in the 2016 election in the State of Florida. I request the release of any and all reports, files, or documentation that can prove and/or verify the existence of specific cases in which voter fraud was committed in the 2016 election in the State of Florida.

Additionally, I am requesting the release of any and all documentation of communications that the Secretary of State's office may have had with the Trump Administration and/or the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity regarding this issue. If no such evidence of said voter fraud exists, I request that the Secretary of State's office officially decline to participate in the Commission's recent request for voters' personal information including Social Security numbers and deny its request based on a lack of any real evidence or standing.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request since the disclosure of the information I seek is not primarily in my commercial interest, and is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government, making the disclosure a matter of public interest. Given that 44 states have declined to provide, in whole or in part, voters' personal information in response to the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity's request, it is clearly in the public interest for Floridians to understand how their state intends to proceed with said request.

Should you deny my request, or any part of the request, please state in writing the basis for the denial, including the exact statutory citation authorizing the denial as required by s. 119.07(1)(e), F.S.
